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General Instructions:

- 1. The application is available at ACEF, through high school guidance counselors, or online at <u>www.annistoncef.org</u>.
- 2. The 2016 Scholarship Deadline is Friday, April 1, 2016 at 5:00PM. No applications emailed or postmarked after this will be accepted. You will be notified in May regarding final decisions.
- 3. Type or print legibly in blue or black ink. Illegible applications will not be considered.
- 4. Do not leave sections blank; if a question does not apply to you, put "N/A." Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Criteria and Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must attend Anniston or Wellborn High Schools, or be a returning scholarship recipient of the Kevin Thompson Scholarship Program.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in a two- or fouryear educational institution.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 2.0 grade point average (or a "C" average).
- 4. Seniors must have either consistently strong academics or be able to demonstrate improvement over their time in high school, as well as a desire to attend college.
- 5. Applicant must plan to pursue or be pursuing a major in Education or Music.
- 6. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement: seniors must be able to show at least 20 hours of community service over their time in high school, while returning applicants must have 40 hours over the previous year. Volunteer hours must be documented and signed off on by a supervisor. These hours may be completed through ACEF.
- 7. Applicants may not be related to any ACEF staff or member of the Board of Directors, or any member of the Kevin Thompson family, as this presents a conflict of interest.
- 8. Applicants must be willing to attend a scholarship orientation with the Anniston Community Education Foundation (at least two spring/summer sessions will be scheduled

Personal Essay (1-2 pages, typed, double spaced, 12-pt Times New Roman font)

Two (2) Letters of Recommendation (at least one of these must be from a high school teacher, counselor, or principal. These should not be from family members)

Most Recent Official High School Transcript (photocopy is acceptable if signed by principal or guidance counselor)

Community Service Hours (please document at least 20 hours of community service during your time in high school; these should be signed by a program supervisor and may be completed through work with ACEF)

Proof of College Acceptance (if you have not yet received this, any award you receive will be conditional upon proof of admission)
