FOP Auxiliary #4: Calhoun Women Behind the Badge Child of Law Enforcement Scholarship

Purpose:

The CWBB Child of Law Enforcement Scholarship was created to provide financial assistance to children of law enforcement officers in need of assistance for higher education. These children are eligible to submit an application for the scholarship, which is a one-time payment in the amount of \$1,000.00.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Applicant must be the dependent child (natural or adopted) of a local, state, or federal law enforcement officer (active service, retired, or deceased).
- Applicant must be a current high school senior or currently attending a community college or 4-year university.
- Applicant must have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.3 or higher.
- Applicant must be a citizen of the United States.

Scholarship Rules:

- All entries will be reviewed by the Calhoun Women Behind the Badge Board and members.
- The winner will be chosen based on adherence to scholarship rules and the quality of the application submitted.
- Scholarship award will be based on the overall merit, determined by CWBB, such as scholastic achievement, character, and extracurricular activities which may also include community service work.
- CWBB will award the scholarship on an annual basis. Scholarships will only be awarded once to each recipient.
- Applications and scholarships will not be judged based on sex, creed, national origin, or religious preference.
- Scholarships are to be awarded (certificate only) in the last week of April.
- Scholarships will be paid directly to the approved educational institution.

Application Requirements:

- Completed Scholarship Application
- Proof of parent of guardian occupation (I.D. or supervisory letter will be accepted)
- Three (3) letters of recommendation (cannot include letter from family member or close friend)
- Current Official transcript
- INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR JUDGING.
- APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED VIA FAX OR EMAIL.
